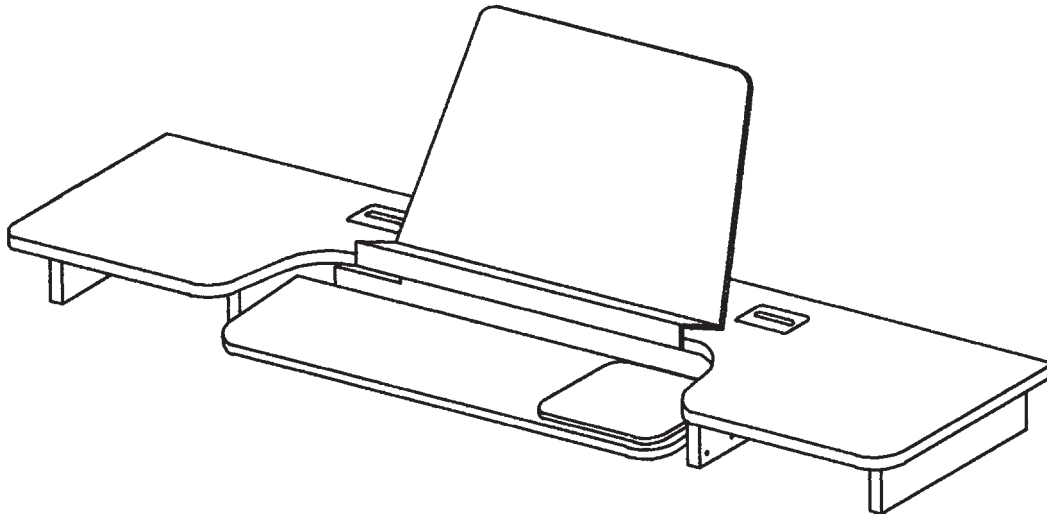

BEFORE YOU BEGIN

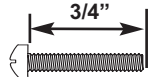
- Read the complete assembly procedure before you begin.
- Remove all items from the shipping carton and lay them out approximately in their final position.

REQUIRED TOOLS

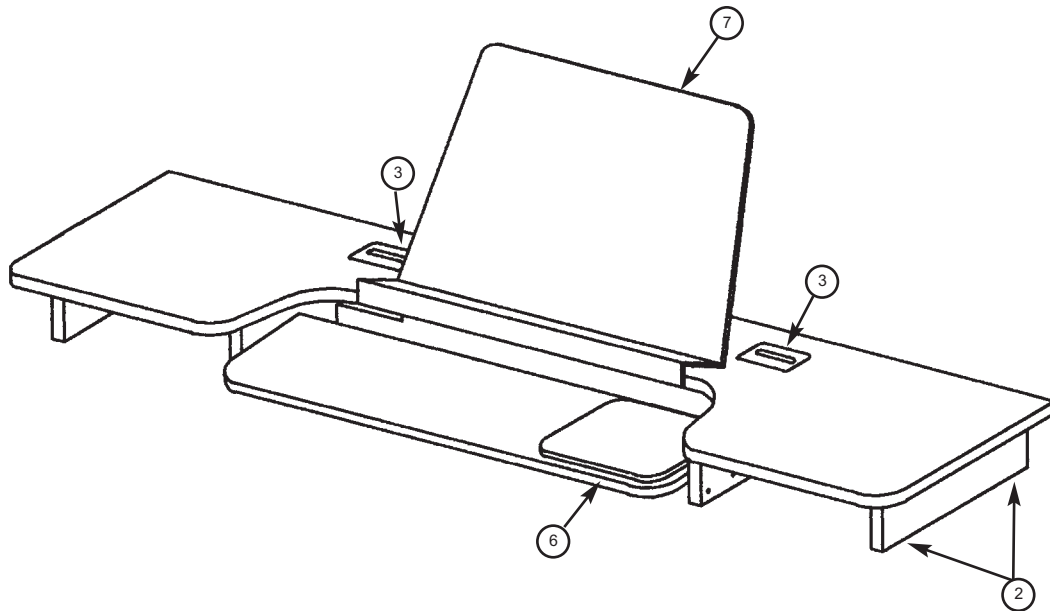
- Phillips Head Screwdriver with a short shaft
- 4 mm hex wrench (supplied), if installing on a 76-key piano.

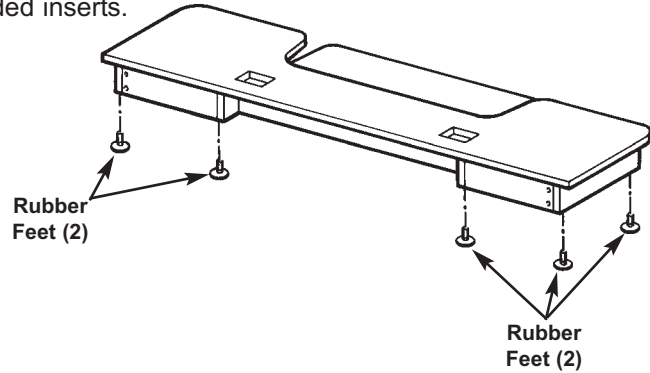

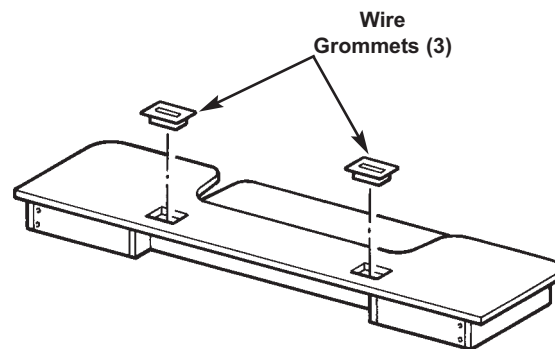
<u>Item</u>	<u>Qty</u>	<u>Description</u>
1	1	Cover, rear, plastic (not shown)
2	8	Foot, rubber
3	2	Grommet, wire
4	4	Screw, machine, 8-32X3/4" (oyster and black)
5	1	Strip, outlet (not shown)
6	1	Pad, mouse
7	1	Holder, music

ASSEMBLY

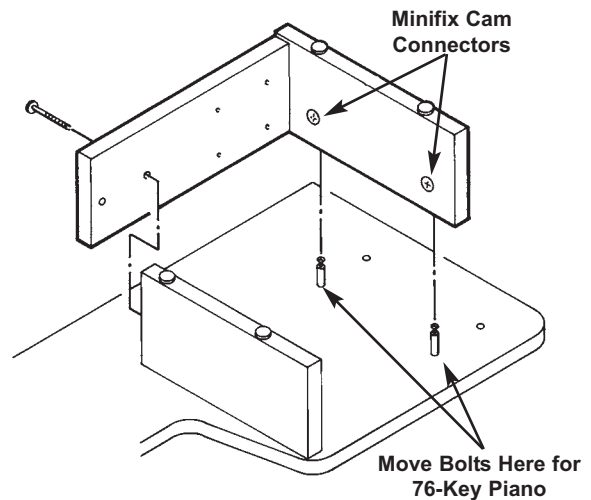
1. Screw the eight rubber feet (2) into the threaded inserts. Tighten securely.



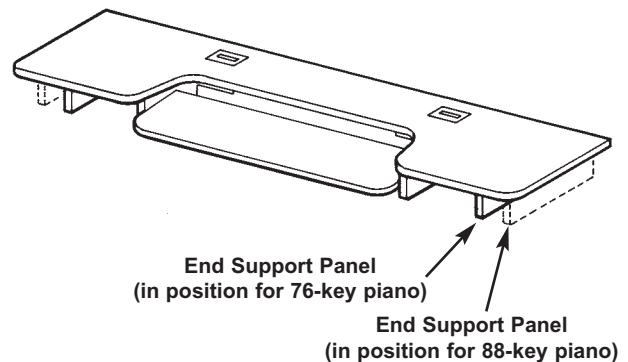
2. Press the wire grommets (3) into the precut holes.



3. The Class Piano Workstation is shipped with the end support panels positioned for an 88-key piano. To install on a (narrower) 76-key piano:
 - a. Turn Workstation upside down.
 - b. With 4 mm hex wrench, unlock the two Minifix cam connectors on each end.
 - c. Remove the two screws from back panel.
 - d. Move Minifix bolts to inner sets of holes.
 - e. Reassemble unit.

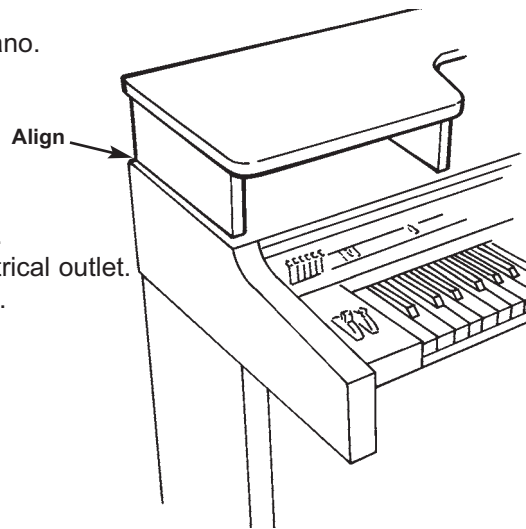


- f. Move both end support panels in as shown.



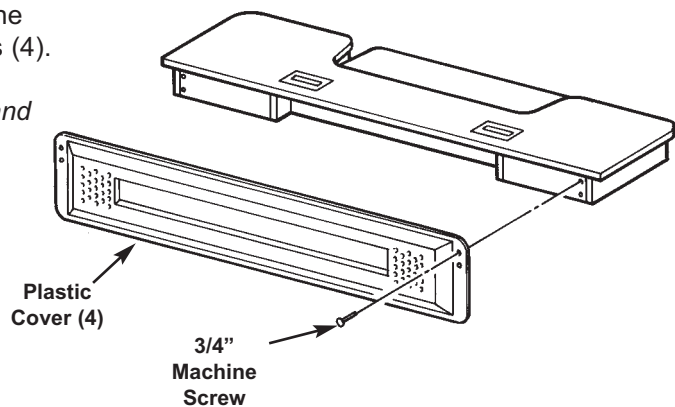
ASSEMBLY (CONTINUED)

4. Set the workstation on the piano.
Align the back of the workstation with the back of the piano.
Press down firmly to secure the rubber feet.
5. Set the computer or other equipment on top of the workstation.
6. Route all power cords and cables:
 - a. Route the computer power cord and cables, MIDI or audio cables, etc., down through the wire grommets.
 - b. Plug the outlet strip power cord into a 115V AC electrical outlet.
 - c. Plug any equipment power cords into the outlet strip.

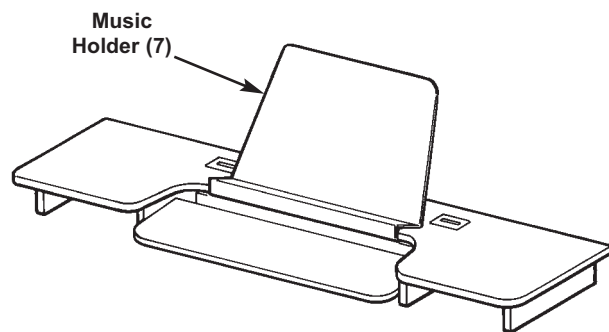


7. Attach the plastic cover (1) to the back of the workstation using four 3/4" machine screws (4).

Note: Use oyster screws with white back and black screws with black back.



8. Install the music holder (7).
Slide it over the front edge of the workstation as shown.



ASSEMBLY (CONTINUED)

9. Place the mouse pad (6) on either the left or right side of the pullout keyboard tray and remove the adhesive-backed paper to install.
