



# **Required Tools**


Depending upon which accessory is being installed, a combination of the following tools may be needed:

- Cordless drill
- 3/8" drill bit (for wood shelf)
- 1-1/4" drill bit (for wood door only)
- Phillips drive bit or screwdriver
- 5/32", 3/16" and 1/4" hex wrench or bits
- 1/2" socket or combination wrench







## **Upper Shelf Adjustment**




### **Upper Shelf Adjustment (continued)**


Steps 3 and 4 apply to grille door and wood door lockers only. For no door lockers, skip ahead to step 5.

3. Drill two 0.375" (9.5 mm) diameter holes through the top shelf to mount the lock tab as shown in the diagram.




## **Upper Shelf Adjustment (continued)**

- 5. Reattach the top shelf into the locker.
  - a. Locate the top of the shelf panel to be the ADA recommended height of 25" (635 mm) above the top of the seat panel.
  - b. Attach the shelf to the sides of the locker using one hook plate cover (1) and three 1/4-20 x 0.708" machine screws (7) and 1/4-20 x 3/8" hex cap nuts (8) on each side.



For no door lockers, installation is complete. For grille door and wood door lockers, proceed to the next page. For lower ADA shelf installation, go to page 15.

#### **Grille Door Bracket Installation**




#### Wood Door Bracket Installation



This procedure is for wood door bracket installation only. For grille door bracket installation, go to the previous page. For lower ADA shelf installation, go to page 15.

1. Drill one 1-1/4" (32 mm) diameter hole through the wood door panel to mount the lock tab as shown in the diagram.




## Wood Door Bracket Installation (continued)



## Final Installation for Lockers with Doors


1. For better accessibility to an ADA locker, remove the pivot plate, shoulder bolts and cap nuts from the top latch assembly.



## **ADA Shelf Installation**


- 1. Attach brackets to the lower locker compartment.
  - ADA recommendations state no reaching lower than 15" (381 mm) up from the floor. The ADA shelf is 3/4" (19 mm) thick, so locate the shelf lip of the ADA Shelf Bracket Assemblies (16) to be a minimum of 14-1/4" (362 mm) up from the floor
  - b. On both the left and right side, fit a bracket onto the wire grille as shown in Detail A. Both brackets must be at the same height.

Slightly stagger brackets in adjacent lockers as shown in Detail B.

- 2. Attach the ADA Shelf.
  - a. Fit the ADA Shelf (15) onto the brackets.
  - b. Secure the shelf to the cage nuts of the bracket assemblies using four 1/4-20 x 1.38" hex head machine screws (14).
