

Intended Use

- This product is intended to transport and display goods both indoors and outdoors during normal ambient temperature and humidity conditions it must not be exposed to prolonged outside weather conditions.
- This product is intended to be operated and moved only as described in these instructions.
- Never leave merchandise inside the Mobile Kiosk when it is parked in an unsecured area.
 A locked Mobile Kiosk is relatively secure, but break-ins are better discouraged by storing it in a locked room or well lighted public area.

Warranty

The GearBoss Mobile Kiosk is covered under a five year Limited Warranty offered to you, the initial purchaser. This Warranty runs from the date of shipment and warrants that the Wenger product will be free of defects in materials or craftsmanship during the warranty period.

This Warranty does not apply to damage caused by common carrier, misuse or abuse, alterations to products not expressly authorized by Wenger. This Warranty does not extend to mechanical or electrical component parts made by others such as: outlet strips, etc. Component parts of this nature are covered under their independent manufactures' warranties. This Warranty does not apply to items that are consumable in nature such as: LEDs, etc. Exact matching of color, grain, texture and lighting is not guaranteed as these features are prone to change and fade over time. Our warranty assures you of, at the discretion of our Customer Service Department, either a full refund, or the repair or replacement of the defective product without charge. An intentional benefit of the GearBoss Mobile Kiosk is repairable and replaceable parts. To achieve this throughbolts are used and on moving parts and the vibration of these connection points can, at times, cause bolts to loosen. Maintenance must be in place to annually check and, if necessary, tighten bolts at these locations.

Make sure that anyone who operates the kiosk has read and understands these instructions.



Always use at least two people to move the kiosk.



Always set the parking brake when the kiosk is parked.



Never move the kiosk over rough or soft terrain.



Never move the kiosk at more than a normal walking speed.



Never load the kiosk with more than 200 lb (91 kg).



Never stand or ride on the kiosk.



Never supply AC power to the kiosk if the ground is wet or if rain is expected.





Never move the kiosk with a motorized vehicle.



Never move the kiosk up or down inclines greater than 5°.



Never move or position the kiosk sideways on an incline.



Never deploy the kiosk when exposed to wind speeds greater than 20 mph (32 kph).



Never move the kiosk when deploved.



If AC power is supplied to the kiosk, always use an outlet that has Ground Fault Circuit Interrupter (GFCI) protection.



Exposing the kiosk to rain or excessive moisture could result in damage.


Moving the Kiosk



Be sure all packaging is removed according to the "Mobile Kiosk Unloading Instructions".


ACAUTION

- Always use at least two people to move the kiosk.
- Pulling a heavy load at high speed can cause a crash.
 Never exceed 10 mph (16 kph) if the kiosk is empty.
 Never exceed 5 mph (8 kph) if the kiosk is loaded or if the surface is uneven.
- Pull the kiosk slowly if turns are tight or if the route includes ramps or inclines.
- 1. Be sure that the door-canopy lock is engaged to secure the doors and canopy.
- 2. Push the brake release lever in with your foot to disengage the parking brake and lower the handle.
- 3. Carefully move the kiosk to the new location.
- 4. With the kiosk in position, raise the handle back up and over the brake release lever to engage the parking brake.




Kiosk Set Up


- 1. Fold down the two stabilizer legs at the front of the kiosk.
 - a. Flip each leg forward until it contacts the ground.
 - b. Slightly push back at the top of the frame to allow better floor clearance while pushing the leg with your foot until it is straight up and down.

2. Unlock the canopy panel and front drawers.






LED Light Fixture




The first time use will require routing and mounting the LED light power cord. These components are stored inside of the plastic storage bins.




Slatwall Kit Components


Mount the slatwall kit components.
 These components are stored inside of the plastic storage bins.



2. At the preferred location, rotate the component back slightly to fit into the slatwall extrusion and lower it to be flush with the panel surface.




Kiosk Take Down



Kiosk Take Down (continued)

- 5. Fold up the two stabilizer legs at the front of the kiosk.
 - a. Slightly push back at the top of the frame to allow better floor clearance while pulling each leg with your foot until they begin to fold in.
 - b. Flip each leg back to rest on the kiosk.



Care and Maintenance

Cleaning

Metal Surfaces

Clean with a mild, non-abrasive soap with warm water and a clean, soft cotton cloth.

Never use an abrasive or harsh cleaning agent or a chemical cleaning agent!

Laminate Surfaces

Use a soft, damp cloth to clean all laminate surfaces. For smudges or fingerprints, dampen a cloth with any standard non-abrasive, non-bleach, household cleaner and wipe clean.

Do not use products with bleach on laminate!

Maintenance

- 1. Periodically check fasteners to ensure that they have not loosened during use.
- 2. Keep tires inflated to 15-20 psi (103-138 kPa).

Transporting the Kiosk

ACAUTION

Make sure to properly secure the kiosk when transporting.

The kiosk may be loaded onto a truck if the following recommendations are observed:

- Load and unload the kiosk from a loading dock.
- Due to its pneumatic tires, road conditions could cause a kiosk to bounce radically.
 Blocking and strapping the kiosk will help prevent damage to the unit or its contents.
- Wood blocking from the truck floor the kiosk frame.
- Heavy duty ratchet strap(s), mounted low on the kiosk, anchored to the truck wall.
- Padding between the kiosk and the truck wall to limit damage to the surfaces.
