


### **A** CAUTION

It is unsafe for only one person to unpackage the tower.

### Required Tools

- Pallet jack
- · Utility knife
- · Cordless drill with phillips head bit
- 1/2" Combination wrench or socket
- 9/16" Combination wrench or socket

### **Before Unpacking**

Do not dissassemble or remove the pallet until instructed to do so.

Units should be unpakaged indoors, in a well-lighted space with a level floor. Choose an area close to the performance space - a backstage scene shop is ideal. Make sure units will fit through any doors between the assembly area and the performance space.


It is recommended that at least two people are used in the unpackaging process.






Plywood Sheet

8. Retract the drive screws to lower the tower back to the ground. All four casters should be touching the ground with the drive screws clear of the pallet.
