- This product is intended to be assembled and used only as described in these instructions.

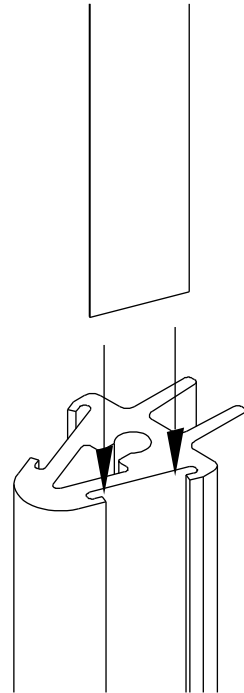
WARRANTY

These products are guaranteed free of defects in materials and workmanship for five full years from date of shipment. A full warranty statement is available upon request.

NUMBERING SYSTEM

1. To assign numbers to individual slots, use enclosed number strips or blank strips. They can be added or removed in the black extrusions as your numbering system changes. Refer to Step 1 under “Changing Shelf Locations” to remove extrusions. Letters or numbers can be written on the strips using ink pen, marking pen or permanent markers and can be easily erased with all purpose cleaner (or industrial cleaner for dry erase markers) or slide the pre-printed enclosed number strip into the slot as shown.

Note: At the top of each number strip, the shelf spacing is identified.



CHANGING SHELF LOCATIONS

A Philips Head Screwdriver is required to change the shelf locations.

1. Wenger Mobile Folio Cabinets are shipped with the shelves already installed. They are held in place by an aluminum extrusion which runs from top to bottom of each compartment.

To change shelf locations, follow these instructions to remove as many of the stops as necessary. After moving the shelves, reinstall the extrusions.

2. To remove the extrusions in the middle of the cabinet, remove the two screws at the top of each extrusion, pull the top of the extrusion forward, and lift the extrusion along with the plastic bracket out of the lower bracket.

Reposition shelves in the appropriate slots prior to replacing the extrusions.
