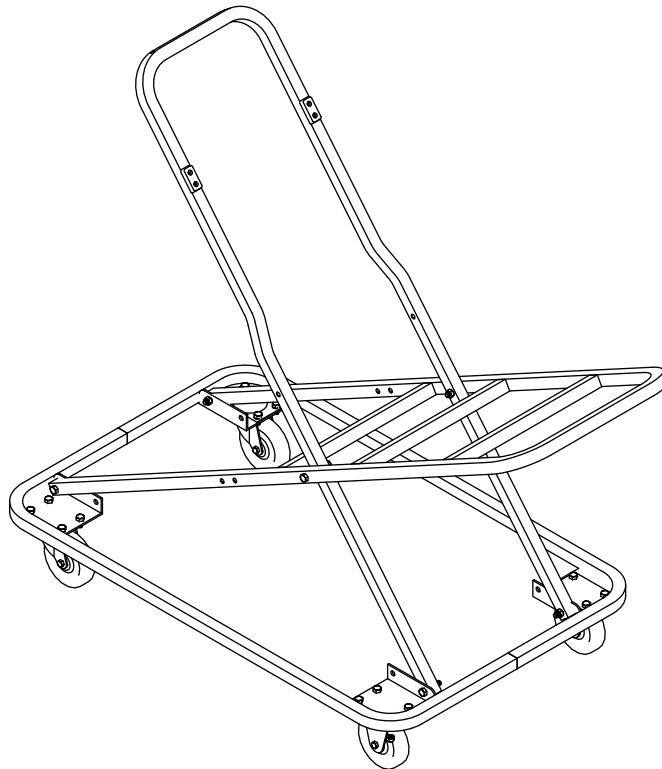

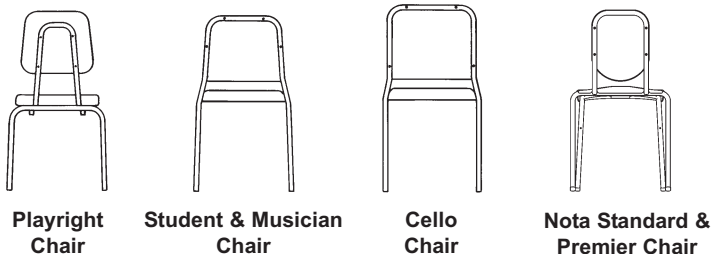

## INTENDED USE

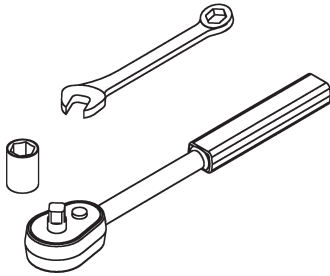
- This product is designed to transport and store Wenger Playright™, Student & Musician, Cello or Nota™ Chairs depending on how it is assembled.

- This product is intended to be assembled only as described in these instructions.

1/2" Combination Wrench and Ratchet with 1/2" Socket



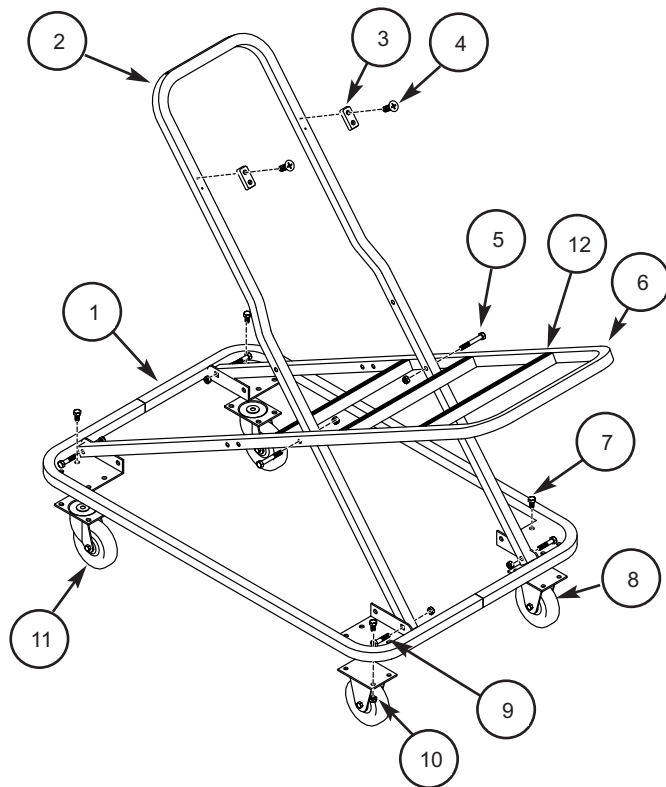
Phillips Screwdriver

# BEFORE ASSEMBLY

Remove all items from the shipping carton, and lay them out approximately in their final position. Refer to the exploded-view drawing below.

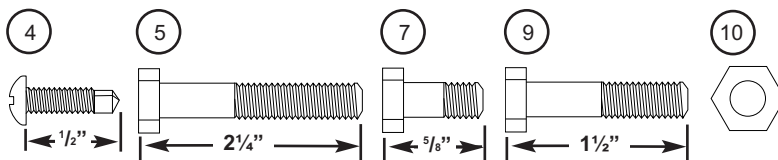
# REPLACEMENT PARTS LIST

4	Screw, drill/tap, #6 x 1/2"	4
5	Capscrew, 5/16-18 x 2 1/4"	2
6	Tube, outside	1
7	Capscrew, 5/16-18 x 5/8"	16
8	Caster, nonswivel	2
9	Capscrew, 5/16-18 x 1 1/2"	4
10	Lock Nut, 5/16-18	24
11	Caster, swivel	2
12	Velcro, 7/8 x 14"	3



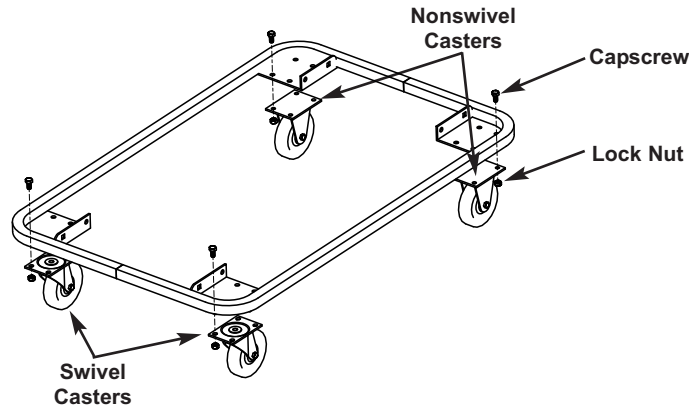

# ASSEMBLY

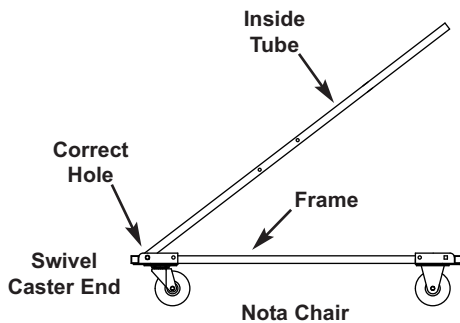
1. Install the two Swivel Casters at one end of the Frame using four  $\frac{5}{16}$ -18 x  $\frac{5}{8}$ " Capscrews and Lock Nuts in each.
2. Install the two Nonswivel Casters at the other end using four  $\frac{5}{16}$ -18 x  $\frac{5}{8}$ " Capscrews and Lock Nuts in each.



3. Attach the Inside Tube to the Frame.

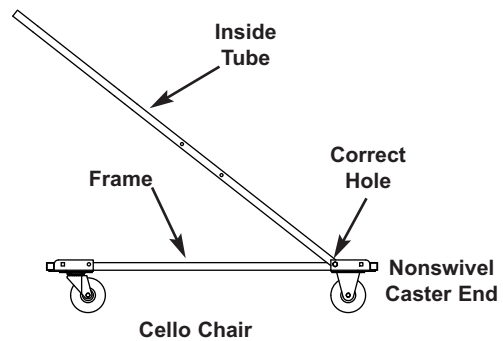
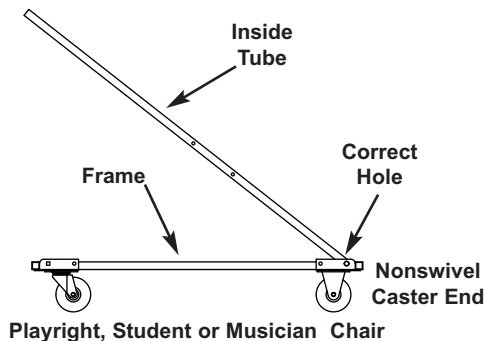
**Nota Cart:**

Attach the Inside Tube to the inside of the Frame at the Swivel Caster end using two  $\frac{5}{16}$ -18 x  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " Capscrews and Lock Nuts. The Capscrews are inserted from the outside of the Frame, see "Replacement Parts List" on page 4 for clarification. Be sure to use the proper holes for the Nota chair, see the illustration below.



**All other Carts:**

Attach the Inside Tube to the inside of the Frame at the Nonswivel Caster end using two  $\frac{5}{16}$ -18 x  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " Capscrews and Lock Nuts. The Capscrews are inserted from the outside of the Frame, see "Replacement Parts List" on page 4 for clarification. Be sure to use the proper holes for the intended chair model, see the illustrations below.



**NOTE:** If unsure about which chair model is being used, refer to the illustrations on page 3.

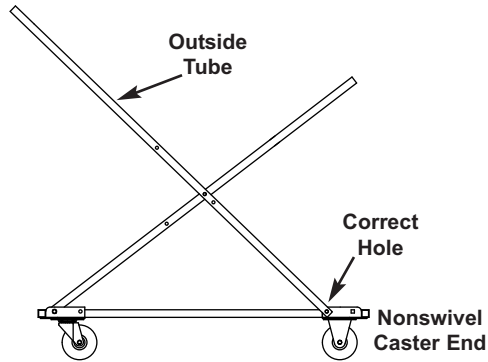
# ASSEMBLY CONTINUED

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4. Attach the Outside Tube to the Frame at the other end.

**Nota Cart:**

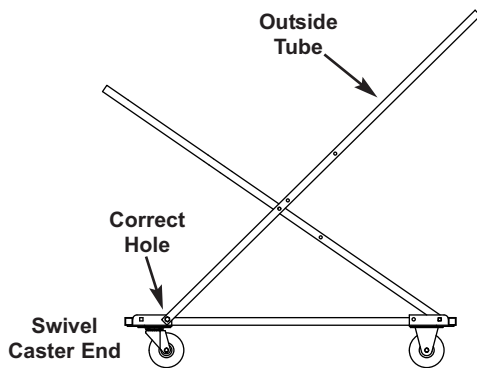
With the velcro side facing up, attach the Outside Tube to the outside of the Frame at the other end (Nonswivel Caster end) using two  $\frac{5}{16}$ -18 x 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Capscrews and Lock Nuts. The Capscrews are inserted from the outside of the Frame, see "Replacement Parts List" on page 4 for clarification. Be sure to use the proper holes for the Nota chair, see the illustration below.



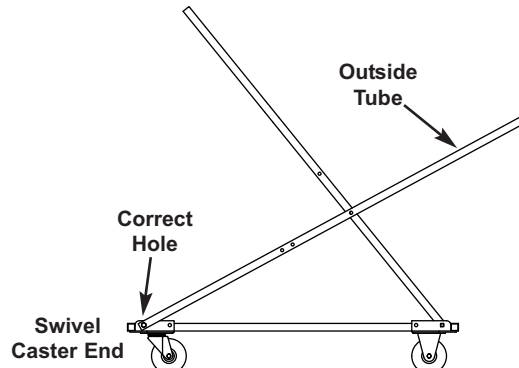

**All other Carts:**

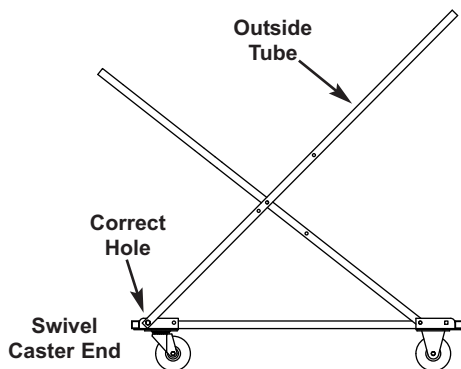
With the velcro side facing up, attach the Outside Tube to the outside of the Frame at the other end (Swivel Caster end) using two  $\frac{5}{16}$ -18 x 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Capscrews and Lock Nuts. The Capscrews are inserted from the outside of the Frame, see "Replacement Parts List" on page 4 for clarification. Be sure to use the proper holes for the intended chair model, see the illustrations below.

Student and Musician Chair

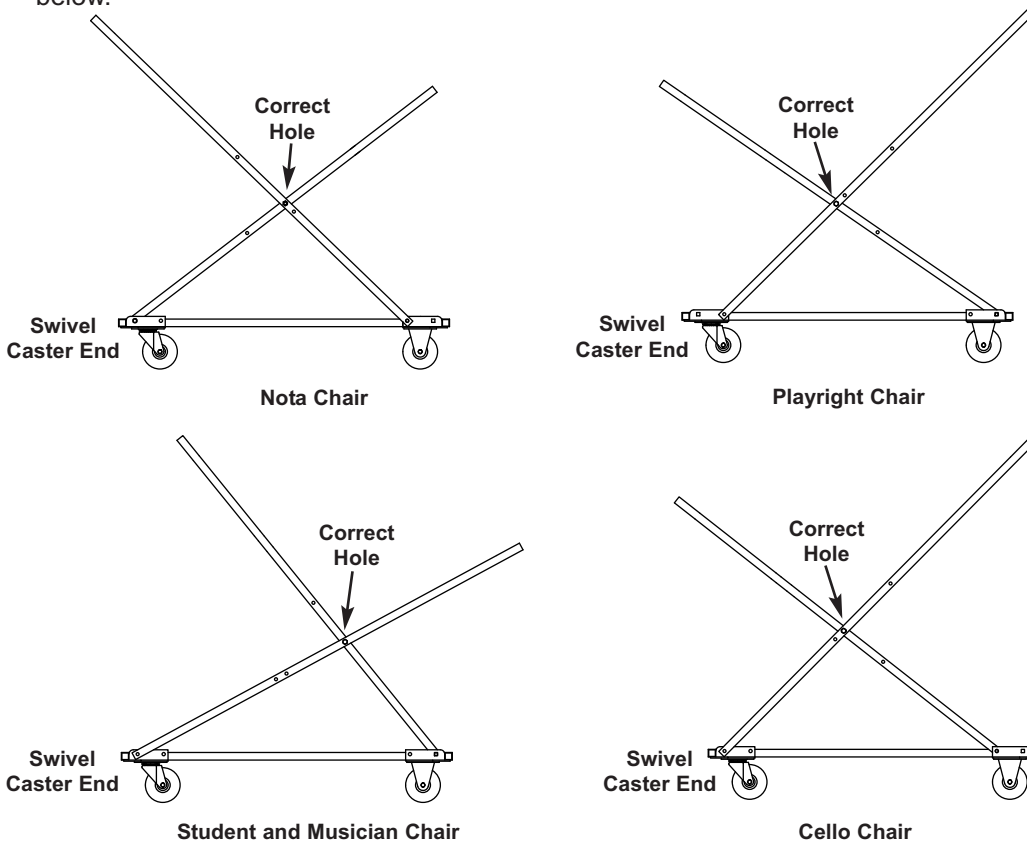


Cello Chair

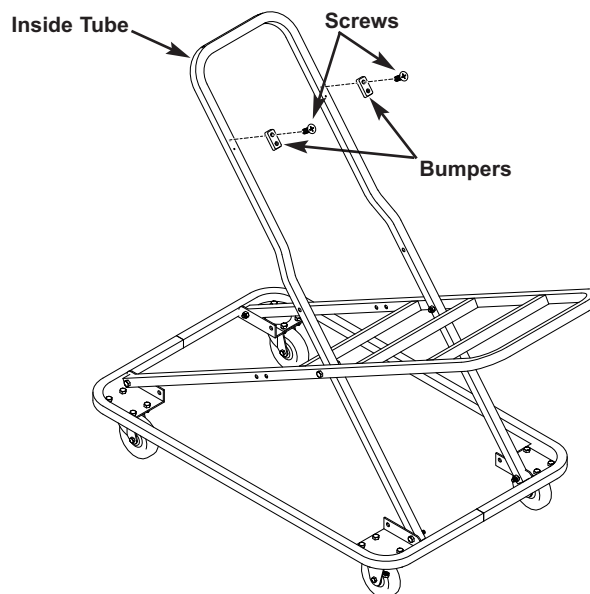
## ASSEMBLY CONTINUED

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5. Attach the Inside and Outside tubes together using two 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" Capscrews and Lock Nuts. The Capscrews are inserted from the outside of the Frame, see "Replacement Parts List" on page 4 for clarification.. Be sure to use the proper holes for the intended chair model, see the illustrations below.



6. Attach the two Bumpers to the Inside tubes using two #6 x 1/2" Screws in each.



7. Be sure that all Capscrews and Locknuts are tightened securely before using the Move & Store Cart.
