REQUIRED TOOLS

The following tools must be supplied by the installer to replace the Front Bumper:

- Electric Drill with 1/8" Drill Bit (to remove old rivets)
- Rivet Gun (to install using rivets)
- Electric Screwdriver or Drill with Phillips Head Bit (to install using screws).




FRONT BUMPER REPLACEMENT

1. If the old Front Bumper and Rivets need to be removed, Drill out the old Rivets or rivet remnants with an Electric Drill fitted with an 1/8" Drill Bit.

2. Place the Front Bumper over the front two center holes in the frame on the bottom of the chair.



3. Secure the Front Bumper to the frame using either two Rivets or two Screws.

- 2 3* 1/8" (0.125 mm) Diameter Rivet, Blind, Grip 0.188/0.25
- 3 3* Screw, Self Tapping, 8-18 x 1/2" Phillips Head

^{*}Only two Rivets or Screws needed. There is a spare of each included.
