


The cart can be used to transport and store the guardrails and backdrop frames that are used with Wenger Staging Systems.


In steps 1 through 5, leave all fasteners slightly loose until the cart is fully assembled.



2. Attach swivel casters (4) at one end of the cart, rigid casters (5) at the other end.

4. Assemble the rail rack, using two rack assemblies (10) and the insert tube (17).

6. Tighten all fasteners securely.
