


Assembly Instructions **Tablet Stand**

REQUIRED TOOLS


The following tools are required to assemble the Tablet Stand:

Plastic or Wood Mallet

- 5/32" (4 mm) Hex Key Wrench
- 7/16" (11 mm) Box End or Socket Wrench
- Pliers


ASSEMBLY

1. Push the Slider Assembly into the Base Assembly.

The Base Assembly may be tapped with a plastic or wood mallet until the Slider Assembly is flush with the bottom of the Base Assembly. Hold the Slider Assembly up from the ground and do not allow it to strike the ground while tapping the Base Assembly or it could be damaged.




Do not allow the Inner Tube to strike the ground. Damage to the components could occur.

2. Attach the Base Assembly to the Slider Assembly using a 1/4-20 x 1.25" Socket Screw.



ASSEMBLY (CONTINUED)

3. Extend the inner tube of the Slider Assembly 3" to 4" (76 to 102 mm) to ease installation of the Pivot Hub.

Insert an allen wrench through the holes at the end of the inner tube and use as a handle to extend the tube.

A pliers may also be used to grasp the wall of the inner tube to aid in extending it.

A CAUTION

Be sure not to distort the shape of the inner tube with a pliers. Damage to the components could occur.

4. Place the Pivot Hub over the Tube Assembly and align the holes in both.





5. Attach the Utility Mount to the Tablet Mount Bracket using a 3/8-16 x 3/4" Carriage Bolt, 3/8" ID Nylon Flat Washer and 3/8-16 Wing Nut.

The Wing Nut has a non-threaded section of nylon that is intended to keep it from loosening after adjustment. A pliers may be required to install the Wing Nut for the first time. It may be easier to hold the Wing Nut with the pliers and turn the Tablet Mount Bracket to tighten it.




ASSEMBLY (CONTINUED)

6. Slide the 1/4-20 x 2" Elevator Bolt through the aligned holes.

Be sure that the square shoulder of the Elevator Bolt slips into the square hole of the Tablet Mount Bracket or the Utility Mount will not tighten properly.

Attach with a 1/4" ID x 1" OD Washer and 1/4-20" Lock Nut using a 7/16" (11 mm) box-end or socket wrench to adjust the desk pivot tension, as necessary.



OPERATION

Use the Tablet Stand with care.

- 1. Move the inner tube of the Slider Assembly up or down to adjust the height of the desk.
- 2. Pivot the Utility Mount to the required angle.

Note: The tension for the angle can be tightened by adjusting the Lock Nut on the Elevator Bolt.
